What's Coworking?

It's a working method that provides for the integration of different skills between freelancers

or

it's a working model adopted mostly by freelancers who use shared spaces in which to have autonomous positions and at the same time interact with other people

or more

it's a work style that involves the sharing of a work environment, often an office, maintaining an independent activity

For Tuscany Region coworking is

an innovative and "smart" working style that

shares a work environment
stimulates and promotes self-entrepreneurship and self-employment activities
improves access to the labor market
supports social inclusion

















Tuscany Region has implemented the measure of coworking starting experimentally in 2014 as part of the Giovanisì project

THROUGH

two public calls

- the first to determine the list of SUPPLIERS of qualified coworking spaces;
- the second to assign individual VOUCHERS through ESF resources.

















An analysis about the results of the experimentation: 66 telephone questionnaires directed to voucherists to:

- investigate their profile
- analyze the coworking experience
- highlight the effects of the coworking experience on the career path of the voucherists
- identify any corrective measures to the coworking action

















The analysis strengths on:

- working in a coworking
- networks and relationships
- sharing and exchange of competences, knowoledges and esperiences

Voucherists find that they have increased:

- Collaborations (97%)
- Competencies (89%)
- Clients (79%)
- Revenue (74%)

















Other results:

- services offered by coworking space in a range from 1 to 5 is 4
- impact of the coworking voucher on the professional path in a range from 1 to 5 is 4

Moreover, at the time of the interview:

67% of the voucherists were continuing or were planning to continue the experience in a coworking space

61% of the interviewers did not find any aspects to be improved in the measure of the coworking voucher



















The re-planning of the measure in 2017

 A new call to update the list of qualified coworking spaces;

A call to grant vouchers to young freelancers.


















33 qualified coworking spaces



















Other 53 voucher assigned for a total of 135 benefits

for a total amount of about 280.000 euros of ESF























A new call in 2018 with several deadlines:

2018:

from 1 to 31 July and from 1 to 31 December

2019 and 2020:

from 1 to 30 April and from 1 to 31 December

















Call addresses to:

- Freelancers;
- Holders of VAT no later than 12 months at the date of presentation of the application form;
- Living and/or working in Tuscany;
- No age limit

















Budget and costs

Total resources € 400,987.00

The maximum amount of each voucher is € 3.500.00.

The voucher finances:

- up to a maximum of € 3,000.00 for the costs of renting the coworking space;
- up to a maximum of € 500.00 for travel, board and lodging expenses, if a collaboration is planned at a coworking space abroad in one of the EU countries or in another Italian region to be carried out within the duration of the voucher.



















the duration of the voucher is from a minimum of 6 to a maximum of 12 months

each candidate can submit only one application for a voucher

the voucher is issued as a refund
